## C. HOME PRICE

The exact sales price of your entry should reflect the selling price including all options, upgrades and additional space finishes of your home on the first day of judging, Friday, April 13

For model homes, the exact sales price should reflect the exact reproduction price of the home effective on the first day of the tour. The HBA must be notified in writing in any situations where model home prices marketed to the public include future carrying costs that indicate a higher price than exact sales price for the contest.

**Revisions to the price above must be submitted in writing by March 15** to guarantee participation in the contest. Changes in price after that date will be adjusted into the appropriate price categories as space allows but are not guaranteed.

NOTE: the exact sales price for the contest is separate from the sales price for the Spring Homes Tour Guide. Prices submitted on the tour entry form or revisions submitted during builder proofing will not be accepted for exact sales price for the contest.

Price Documentation Deadline: MARCH 15, Builders are required to provide documentation to support the Exact Sales Price of this contest entry. Accepted documents include sales flyers, pricing lists, Multiple Listing Service (MLS) and are due by March 25. ### E. JUDGING

**Price Categories:** Each home is assigned a price category by the Tour Committee after all contest entries have been submitted. The contest categories are not pre-set. They are determined by the number of entries submitted in those price ranges.

**Judges:** Industry professionals from across the country are recruited especially to judge your home(s) for these competitions.

**Drivers:** Your company has the opportunity to volunteer as a driver. Drivers host a team of judges by navigating through the Kansas City area suburbs. The contests would not be possible without these volunteers.

If you are a Grand and/or First Runner-Up winner from the previous 2009 Parade of Homes contest, you are required to provide a driver for one day of judging for this contest. Your driver can be a representative from your company or someone you do business with (banker, subcontractor).

#### **Please Note Minimum Standard Rule:**

For price categories containing only one or two homes, there will be no automatic awarding for Grand Prize or First Runner Up awards. To win these awards, a home must score 95% of the average score of all the Grand Prize winners or 90% of the average score of all the First Runner Up winners.

### F. BUILDER AGREEMENT

1. I hereby certify that I have read, understand and will abide by all the rules of this contest and that all of the information on this form is correct.
2. I understand that not abiding by the rules set forth in this contest may constitute a penalty in future tours and return of any awards should the information be found inaccurate.
3. I agree to have my home 100% complete by Wednesday, April 4. if my home will not be completed on time I will call the HBA before Friday, March 30 to withdrawal from the contest. Failing to notify the HBA of a withdrawal will result in a \$200 fine.
4. I agree to have my home open for judging on Friday April 13 from 8:30 am until 6:00pm and Saturday, April 14 from 8:30 am until 5:00pm. I realize that I will be fined \$200 and my home will be disqualified if it is not accessible to the judges. The HBA will notify your company before judging as to which day your home will be judged.
5. I understand that I may not enter this home in a contest if it has previously won an award for a previous Pick of the Parade or American Dream Award contest.
6. I understand if I win a First Runner-Up or Grand Award for the 2012 American Dream Award, I am required to provide a driver as a representative of my company or someone I do business with to drive the judges one day for the next contests –Pick of the Parade or Distinctive Plan & Design Award contest in the fall of 2012.
7. I understand the rules set surrounding the exact sales price of my homes as outlined under Home Price. If there is discrepancy with the sales price for any reason, the home may be disqualified and any awards forfeited.
